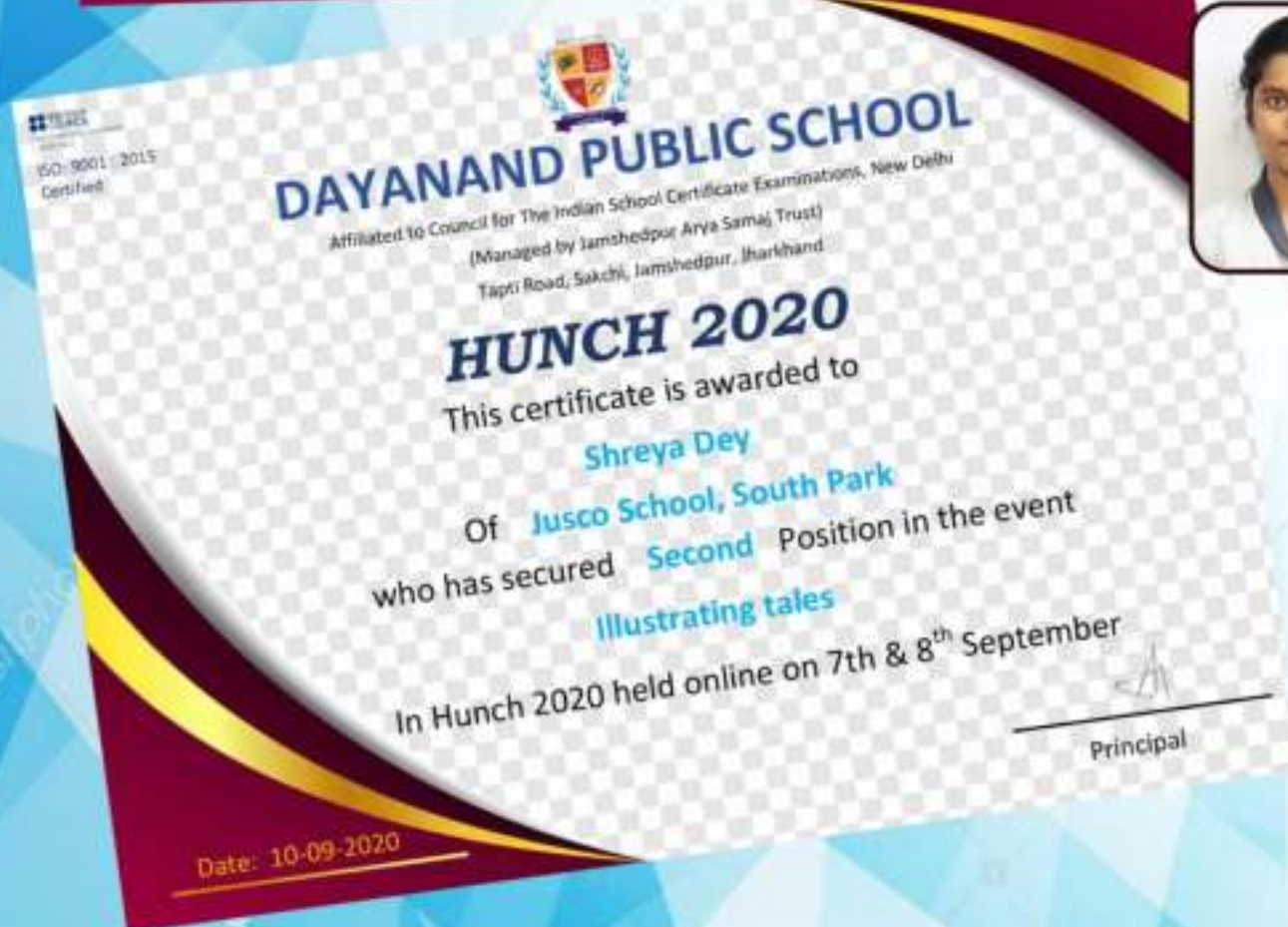

1. When you saw your NEET result for the first time what was your immediate reaction?

AKASH: I was really surprised and was happy as well.

ABHAY: I was happy and little disappointed at the same time because my rank did not comply with my marks.

2. Did you ever expect such remarkable result?

AKASH: NO, I was not expecting such a great result though I knew the exam went off well but such a great result was unexpected.

ABHAY: YES, I expected a good result because I was confident about my preparation.

3. Apart from your determination, hard work and sincerity whom would you like to give the credit for this achievement?

AKASH: I would like to give the credit to my beloved parents, my teachers and friends.

ABHAY: I would like to give credit to my parents, specially my mom and my uncle, teachers and of course my friends.

4. "It is said that Mathematics is the language of Physics." Being a Bio student how did you manage Physics without the support of Mathematics?

AKASH: Mathematics was my favourite subject since childhood, so I did not face any difficulty in studying Physics.

ABHAY: Generally students who want to avoid Mathematics choose Bio, but if you study Mathematics till class X then you can easily understand the concepts of Physics.

5. What other tips would you like to give to the Bio students who are aspiring for NEET?

AKASH: Just focus on what is taught in your school . Regular self study habits and self discipline can help you to clear NEET.

ABHAY: **"BE CONFIDENT BUT NOT OVER CONFIDENT"** Go through NCERT books at least 15 to 20 times especially Biology & solve as many numericals as you can in Physics .

6. Last moment revision can turn tables and become a key factor for your success. Do you believe in this and did it work for you?

AKASH: Yes, revision is an important factor. It really worked for me. Revision helps you to be confident and also while giving exam it won't let you forget what you have studied.

ABHAY: "REVISION BEGINS WITH THE FIRST DAY OF LEARNING". If you haven't studied the whole year then the last moment revision/learning can't do a miracle. You should start preparing for your exam seriously from the very beginning.

7. In the presence of so many gadgets and social media around us, how can a student maintain his concentration and keep himself or herself motivated?

AKASH: A student must stay focused towards his goal and learn to use the gadgets and social media judiciously. **EXAMPLE :** Instagram is a social media site where a student can get distracted as well as determined. Distracted because, of memes etc. which leads to wastage of time and determined because of various examination and study related pages.

ABHAY: At this age students who cannot keep themselves away from social media should restrict themselves and keep a phone with only call facility . Having internet facility and apps like Whatsapp ,Facebook or Instagram will only lead to distractions.

8. Do you think that discipline is an important ingredient for success? What message would you like to give to your juniors in this regard?

AKASH: YES, discipline is very important in order to achieve our goals. Students should maintain a proper routine and should adhere to it.

ABHAY: YES, "Discipline is the bridge between goals and accomplishment" If a student wants to achieve his goals he/she should stay disciplined.

9. What are your hobbies and were you able to pursue these hobbies while preparing for boards as well as NEET Examination?

AKASH: "Exercise not only your changes body it also changes your mind, your attitude and your mood." So after studying for 11 to 12 hours I use to play football and listen to music in order to relax my mind.

ABHAY: I too believe that playing games is important. I use to play badminton and dance as well. My school helped a lot in order to pursue my hobbies while preparing for exams.

10. In today's world we are loaded with too many responsibilities and targets. Please advise us on how to manage time effectively for all these activities?

AKASH: We should manage our time sincerely because we can't compromise with our goals as well as studies but we can manage both wisely.

ABHAY: Yes, I too believe that time management is necessary so we should utilize our 24 hours wisely.

11. Describe some unforgettable memories from your school life in JSSP?

AKASH: School life is the best phase of our life. I have endless memories of my school but the best ones are celebrating Teachers' Day, Children's Day and Christmas together.

ABHAY: The last day of mine in JSSP is still an unforgettable memory. Teachers and our juniors did not leave any stone unturned to make our last day memorable.

12. Who is your inspiration?

AKASH: I am my own inspiration because I firmly believe that I have the determination that I can achieve anything that I can dream of by trying to do better than the previous day thereby developing better self esteem and confidence.

ABHAY: My uncle has been my greatest inspiration since childhood. He has taught me to stay focussed and goal oriented, no matter what obstacles come my way. This has greatly attributed to my success.

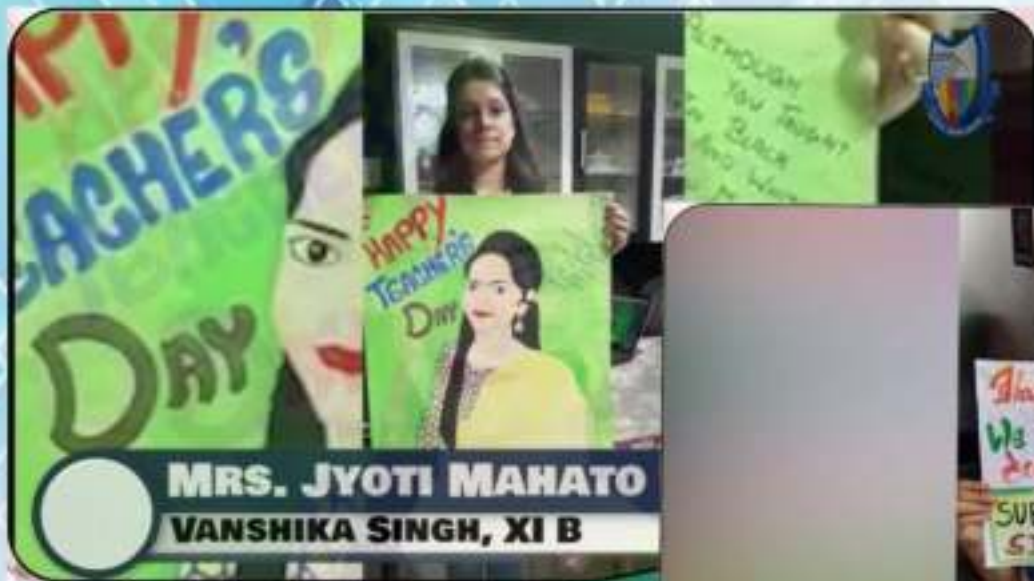
