### Stutee in Conversation with Amisha Pal

1) It is said that discipline plays a very important role in achieving our goals. What was the role of discipline in your achievements?

STUTEE - I think discipline plays a very important role in people's life. I have not been too disciplined rather I am a goal oriented person. I always focus on what I want to achieve and then I work towards it.

2) What are your views on hard work and smart work? Is smart work all that we need for success or hard work also plays an equal role?

STUTEE - I think Hard work and Smart work are not separate from each other. Smart work is Hard work with a strategy and once you are on track finding the right strategy for yourself then it is not difficult. I think smart work brings you better results. In a long run if you keep on putting raw efforts after a point you will feel burnt out and not have any energy to learn new things or revive yourself. So I think if you do it with a strategy you can do multiple things at a same time with efficiency.

3) What were the contribution of your parents, teachers and friends in your achievements?

STUTEE - My parents, teachers and friends have helped in shaping me what I am today. My parents and brother are my backbone. I offer gratitude to my teachers who taught me to be confident and always motivated me to bring out the best in me. My best friend has been my support system from the last four years. I really feel blessed to have such wonderful people in my life.

4) You have spent 15 years as a JSSPian. How was your experience as a student of JSSP?

STUTEE - I have seen many ups and downs as a student but the friendly attitude of my teachers and the support of the administrative staff helped me to nurture and bloom into a confident individual. The last two years spent at JSSP makes me nostalgic. I have beautiful memories of my school.

5) What is your favourite pastime or how do you entertain yourself?

STUTEE - I love reading, painting and writing poetry in my leisure time. Presently i am studying fine arts and I am in second year. I love listening to music and recently I have found a new hobby. I love to listen to the broadcasts from spotify. As of now this is my favourite pastime.

6) "It is during our darkest moments that we must focus to see the light." What were the darkest moments of your 17 years and how you had faced those?

STUTEE - Life has not been a garden of roses for me. I have faced hostility of my peers which compelled me to go into isolation. My teachers pulled me through this and made me feel safe and protected. They made me realise that running away from a situation is not the answer but facing the adverse situation with confidence brings out the best in one self.. 7) How did you develop your problem solving capacity and confidence? What will be your suggestion to your juniors on developing confidence and solving problems?

STUTEE - The attitude that you exhibit towards your problem speaks volumes about the solution. A positive approach and guidance from the seniors helps you to tackle the problem. Preparedness boosts your confidence .Failures are stepping stones to success, so failing does not mean the end of the world. FAIL means first attempt in learning. My suggestions for my juniors is that do not fear failures . Be consistent and honest in your efforts .

### 8) What inspired you to have your own MUN organisation?

STUTEE - I always wanted to do something of my own where people could discuss, talk and debate about certain issues and offer solutions to the topics which are considered as controversial in the world. MUN gave me this platform where unconventional topics could be debated and appropriate solutions were drawn out.

My school Principal guided and motivated me in this endeavour.

9) What were some of the challenges that you faced in your start up how did you tackle those?

STUTEE-I think the biggest problem was my inexperience and I tackled it because my managing committee were far more experienced than me. We had people studying in higher universities. I got rid of inexperience through that and the other thing was that the other delegates who participated they were of such a standard that they did 100 MUN some did 30 MUN and had a very high level of experience so there was a kind of nervousness that I have to give them a good experience. There were some issues that happened during the MUN but then we got help from the delegation circuit and a strict action was taken against the same.

10) What is your stand on stress and depression? How do you handle it? Is there any suggestion you want to give to your juniors as depression is a very common and a very major issue these days?

STUTEE - My stand on depression is that there is lot of taboo about depression and mental illness in the society. Nobody listens to them and hear their sides and in that case there is a huge gap and that person gets lonely and loneliness did no good to anyone because if you are secluded you cannot be helped. And I think this makes it difficult for people to go through this. In order to go through stress I think people can attend sessions and have therapy. I do yoga and meditation to handle stress. And mostly I stayed away from social media for a long time because I think this is very toxic and is not for everyone. I talk to my friends and use creativity as an outlet for my emotions which helped me a lot in handling stress.

### CRYPOTCURRENCY

Cryptocurrency is a digital or virtual currency that is secured by cryptogaphy. It is of various types and many of them are decentralized networks based. The word crypto means secret and the currency means the medium to buy or purchase any goods and services. It is derived from the encryption techniques which are used to secure the network. A defining feature of cryptocurrencies is that they are generally not issued by any central authority, and also not used directly as money to purchase any thing. It is totally based upon the blockchain [the method for ensuring the integrity of transactional data, an essential component of many cryptocurriecies].

Cryptocurrencies face criticism for a number of reasons, including their use for illegal activities, exchange rate volatility, and vulnerabilities of the infrastructure underlying them. However, they also have been praised for their portability, divisibility, inflation resistance, and transparency.

There are many types of cryptocurrency present now a days. The first block-chain based was bitcoin, which still remains most popular and most valuable. Today there are thousands of alternate cryptocurrencies with various functions and specifications. Some of these are clones while others are new currencies that were built from scratch. Bitcoin was launched in 2009 by a group pseudonym and there are 18.6 million bitcoins in circulation with a total market cap.

The advantage of cryptocurrencies include holding the promise of making it easier to transfer funds directly between two parties, without the need for a trusted third party like a bank or credit card company.

These transfers are instead secured by the use of public keys and private keys and different forms of incentive systems, like proof of work or proof of stake.

The disadvantages include its usage (especially bitcoin) a good choice for conducting illegal business online. The forensic analysis of the bitcoin blockchain has helped authorities arrest and prosecute criminals. The market price for cryptocurrency are also on supply and demand. Cryptocurrency blockchains are highly secure, but other aspects of a cryptocurrency ecosystem. reduce its efficacy Bitcoin is by far the most popular cryptocurrency, followed by others such as etherum, litecoin, and cardano. Cryptocurrency allows for secure payments online which are denominated in terms of virtual "token".

The prize distribution for the other classes (Nursery – Std XI) including the Std X board exam toppers was conducted virtually on YouTube on 16th February.
















